STEPS TO BECOME A PERFECT PAIR SITTER PARENT

Complete the Form:

Visit our website at www.perfectpairaupairs.co.za and fill out the application form.

Initial Response:

We will contact you within 1-3 working days.

Documentation and Quote:

You will receive all necessary documents and a quote for the required hours via email.

Registration Fee:

A registration fee of R300 is required to proceed with the process.

Position Listing:

Your position will be listed on our website, with all personal information kept confidential.

Candidate Interest:

When a candidate expresses interest in your position, you will be informed and provided with their details.

Interview Scheduling:

If you are interested in the candidate, an interview will be arranged.

Finalization:

If it's a perfect match, the quoted fee must be paid before the candidate begins work.

Thank you for choosing us to find your perfect pair.

Specify Requirements:

When filling out the form on our website, be very specific with your requirements, including the hourly or monthly rate/salary.

Conduct Thorough Interviews:

If you are uncertain about any details or information, take the time to conduct more than one interview with the candidate(s).

By following these steps, you increase the likelihood of finding the perfect match for your needs.

Fees

Registration fee: R300

The registration fee covers administrative costs and includes adding your profile to our website for candidates to view. This fee ensures that your profile receives visibility and is accessible to potential candidates seeking opportunities.

View our Packages:

Package 1 : Daily (1 day)

Package 2 : Weekly (1+day)

Package 3 : Monthly (7+ days)

Package 4 : Annual (30+days)

Quoted fees:

Your quote will be based on the details you provide in the form, ensuring it accurately reflects your specific requirements and preferences.

Please note that the quoted fees are exclusively for the agency. You will receive a contract between the agency and yourself, as well as a separate contract between the candidate and the parent. This fee also secures the placement for the required duration.

PLEASE NOTE:

Candidate Payment:

As the parent, you are responsible for paying your candidate as discussed during the interview.

Timeline:

It can take up to 1-5 weeks to find your perfect candidate.

Replacement Au Pair:

If you're unhappy with the au pair, a replacement au pair will be suggested free of charge.

Au Pair Requirement:

1 month of working needs to take place before a replacement au pair will be suggested.

Replacement Matching:

A replacement candidate can take up to 2-5 weeks to match your position.

Decision Period:

You have up to 3 days to decide whether to employ the candidate and must inform the agency immediately once a decision is made.

Further Interviews:

If the agency does not receive your decision within 3 days, the candidate will proceed to attend other interviews.

Sitter Payments guidelines

In South Africa, the rates for babysitting, house sitting, and pet sitting can also vary based on similar factors as mentioned before, but with local considerations.

Here are some general guidelines for South Africa:

Babysitting

Experience and Age of Sitter:

- Teenagers typically earn less than adults, with more experienced sitters earning higher rates.

Number and Age of Children:

- More children or younger children can result in higher rates.

Duration and Timing:

- Higher rates for late nights, holidays, or long hours.

Typical Rates:

- R50 to R100 per hour for a standard babysitting job. More experienced or certified sitters may charge more.

House Sitting

Responsibilities:

- Basic house sitting (just being present) typically costs less.
- Additional tasks like watering plants, handling mail, or minor maintenance can increase the rate.

Duration:

- Longer engagements may have different rates compared to short-term ones.

Typical Rates:

- R150 to R400 per day, depending on the level of responsibility and location.

Pet Sitting

Type and Number of Pets:

- More pets or pets requiring special care (medication, special diets) can increase rates.

Services Provided:

- Basic feeding and walking vs. more intensive care or overnight stays.

Typical Rates:

- R100 to R250 per visit for standard pet sitting tasks. Overnight pet sitting might cost more, ranging from R200 to R500 per night.
